



The Montana Department of Transportation (MDOT) removes animals that are killed by motor vehicle collisions to reduce further risk to motorists and other wildlife that are attracted to the carcasses. Road kill is taken to isolated areas far away from highways. Since the late 1990's MDOT has kept records of the location, species and date for most road kill in the state. Bigfork High School's AESOP class, working in partnership with MDOT and Northwest Connections, compiled and analyzed 11 years of road kill data from Highway 83. This poster shows density, yearly changes, and monthly changes for all species of road kill.


